### CRITERIA SHEET FOR LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS

(Information released on February 9, 2009)

The following scholarships are available to graduating seniors of Council Rock High School North. These scholarships are categorized as: *Need-Based or No-Need-Based*. Need-based scholarships **MUST** be accompanied by Page 1 of the original *Student Aid Report (SAR) Estimated Family Contribution Sheet* sent to you as a result of filing the FAFSA. No other form will be accepted! (This form will be returned to you).

Applications for all these scholarships can be obtained at the Career or Counseling Center. A *Common Application* is attached and it may be used for a great number of the existing scholarships. In addition, those scholarships scored with an asterisk (\*\*) require completion of a *separate* application. Where there is an individual application, the selection process is usually determined by the specific organization. **Thursday, March 12, 2009, 3:00 p.m. is the deadline for ALL applications and will be adhered to exactly!!!**

You are applying for scholarships sponsored by individuals, families, and organizations. Be sure to represent yourself in a positive manner by completing the applications in a neat, well-written, grammatically correct and timely fashion. Remember you are asking to be recognized for excellence!!!

Please read this information very carefully. All applications must be returned to **Mr. DeMaio** in the Counseling Center.

**REMEMBER!!** The Student Aid Report (SAR), Page 1, must be included when requested. Proof of major must be submitted when required. If you wish to be considered for need-based scholarships, the Student Aid Report-Estimated Family Contribution form can be submitted until **April 24<sup>th</sup>**. The applications still must be submitted by **March 12, 3:00 p.m.** If you have a problem, see Mr. DeMaio in the Counseling Office **before** the deadline.
