

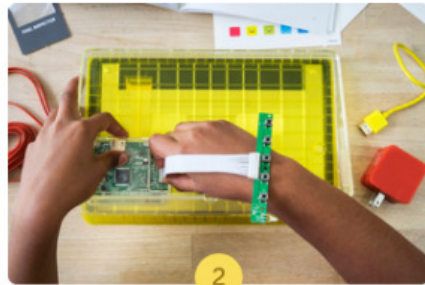
RHE Computer & Coding Club

Who: 4th, 5th & 6th Grade RHE Student (limited to 38 students)

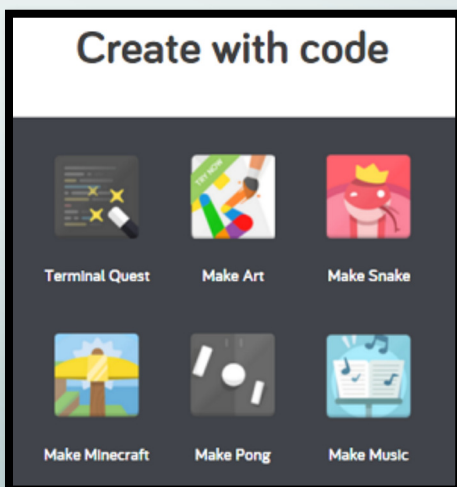
Time: 3:45-4:45 p.m. (RHE Art Room)
