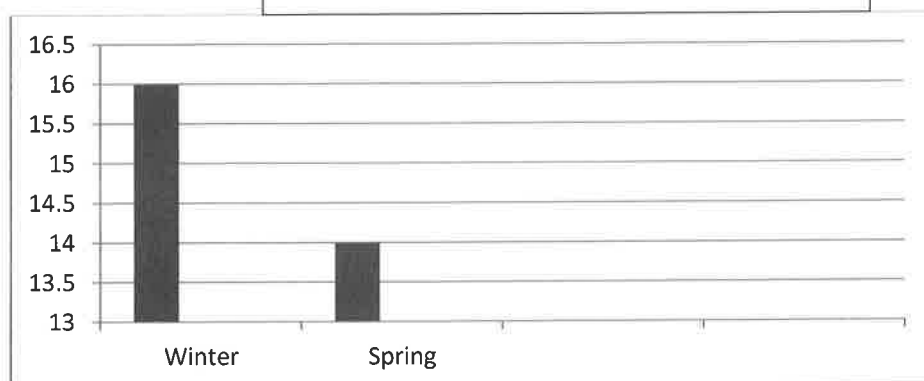

Colby-"I didn't like not being able to go a lot of times."

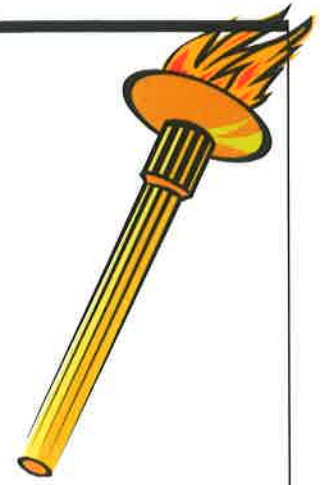
Alyssa-"They were super fun and I want to do them again."

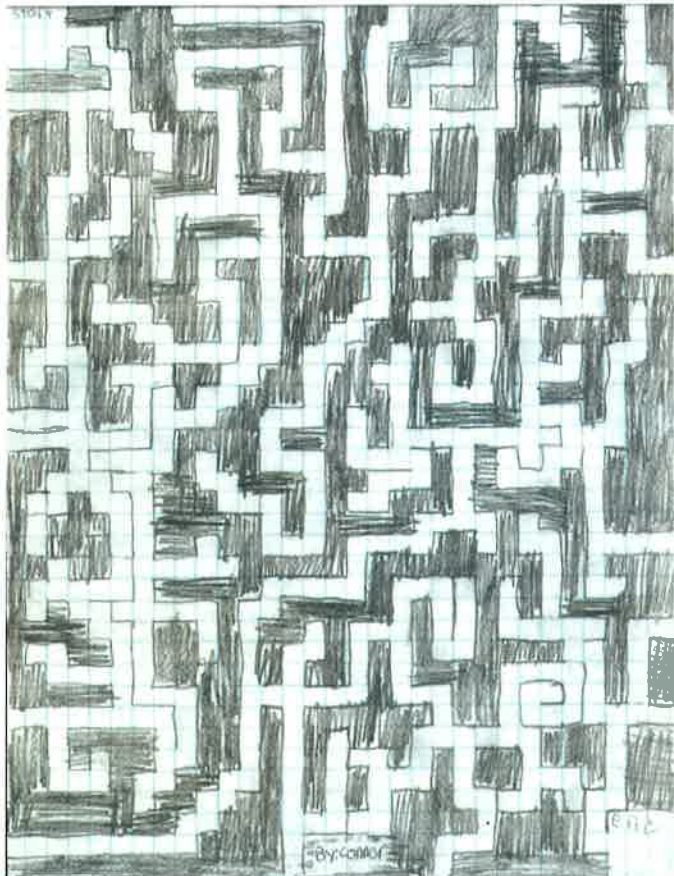
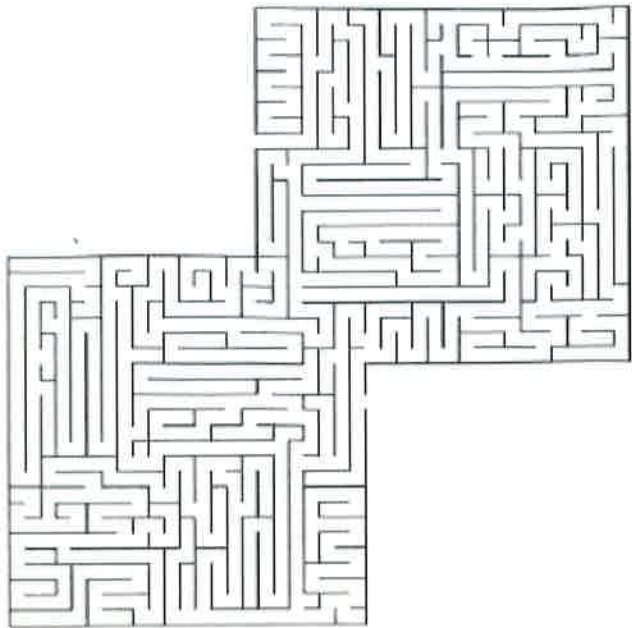
“The NFC Championship was our Super Bowl. The 49ers were the second best team in my opinion.”

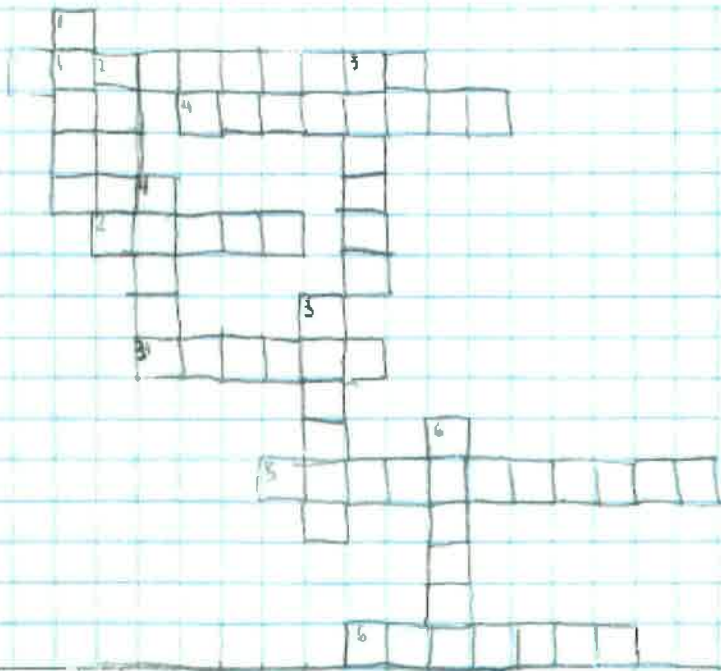
