Council Rock SD Revised Redistricting Proposal

The CRSD Redistricting Committee, comprised of two parent representatives from each building, three building administrators, and five central office administrators reconvened with the new demographer, Cropper GIS/McKibben Demographics on Monday, September 17, 2018. The committee used the updated demographic study and Cropper's analysis of their most recent progress from February 2018 to review boundary lines and develop the proposed redistricting maps.

The proposed plan brings each school close to average capacity for each respective level, balances enrollment at the secondary level by shifting students from the south to the north, and eliminates elementary islands. The proposed plan shifts approximately 16.5% of elementary students.
