

EXPECTATIVAS DE LA CLASE:

1. Participate, collaborate, and make an effort to communicate in Spanish at all times.
2. Come to class prepared with all notes/assignments/materials.
3. Be in your seat and ready when the bell rings (no phones, outside work, books, or other personal items on your desk).
4. Show respect at all times through your words and actions (Ex: Stay positive! Please, no cursing, complaints, put-downs, using phones, or destroying/de-facing property).
5. Stay on-task (Spanish classwork), in the classroom, and follow directions the first time.
6. Complete and correct work individually on-time and without the aid of online tools/translators.
7. Clean up after yourself, and return supplies before you leave the classroom.
8. Pay attention, and ask appropriate questions.



EXAMENES, EXAMENCITOS, Y PROYECTOS:

- At times, projects will be started in the classroom and be finished at home. At other times, projects will be done completely at home. Each project will be graded at a different scale and you will be made aware of the points when receiving the project guidelines.

PARTICIPACIÓN:

- Your participation demonstrates that you are trying and you are interested in all aspects of learning a new language. Therefore, you will receive a participation grade every two weeks for every quarter.
- If you do not participate in class OR are hindering others from learning, it will negatively affect your grade.



AUSENCIAS:

It is the **student's responsibility** to acquire any work that was given during his/her absence from a classmate or from the absent folder at the front of the classroom.

Students are expected to turn in work that was due, make any necessary arrangements, and to make up any quizzes or tests **on the day they return or via email.**

TAREA:

- You will have homework several times a week. It is meant to reinforce content discussed in class.
- Homework is expected to be completed on its due date. LATE work will not be accepted. However, I know after school can get complicated! THEREFORE, you will receive two HW passes each quarter to help out! Use them wisely!!
- All homework must be fully completed to receive full credit. If you do not understand it or a certain section, please check your notes, call a friend from class, or do your best to complete it, or email me and let me know.
- If at any point, you begin to miss homework frequently, I will communicate with home.
- You are responsible for making up all work you miss.
