



DRESS REHEARSAL INFORMATION

February 21, 2018

Dear Holland Families,

As we gear up for our two dress rehearsals, we wanted to provide more information about what to expect. Our students have been working so hard and we truly appreciate all of your support. Our dress rehearsals are critical to the success of our show. We condensed a lengthy and complicated show into two short months of rehearsals, so every moment of practice time counts! If you anticipate any conflicts, please let us know.

Dates/Times: Sunday, February 25th and Saturday, March 3rd are the TWO dress rehearsals. We will be practicing from 9-3 each day. Students may begin arriving no earlier than 8:45 am that day. Please plan to drop off your child. We know you may be excited to preview show, however for safety and focus of the students, these are closed rehearsals.

Lunch: Pizza lunch, snacks, and juice/soda will be provided at each rehearsal. If your student needs an alternate lunch order due to allergies or medical concerns, please let us know.

Water Bottles: Please have your child bring a labeled water bottle to practice that day.

Costumes: Students should not arrive in costumes; they should bring their costumes in labeled bags, including all accessories and shoes. We suggest students wear something that would go underneath a costume - like tanks and leggings for girls, and t-shirts and shorts for boys, to make for quick costume changes. We plan to run through the show first without costumes and then in costumes after lunch. If we feel there are any missing items, or costume suggestions, we will send you an email.

Costume Contribution: During our initial meeting, we estimated the cost of costumes to be approx \$25.00 per student. Since then, we have been working on purchasing/making items for some costumes, and have asked for simple items from parents. In lieu of putting together a full costume, we ask for the following donations (**Cash Please**):

\$20.00 for the following students: Wonka, Violet, Oompa-Loompas, Squirrels, Cooks, Candy Kids)

\$10.00 for Stage Crew
