**Request for Information (RFI) No. 1  
Issue Date: January 31, 2020**

Below are the answers to questions submitted by prospective bidders as of January 30, 2020.

- 1. When was the last RFP issued for this contract?**
  - a. 2009
- 2. Is there a specific reason it is being issued now? (i.e. parent complaints, district interested in additional revenue, etc.)**
  - a. Council Rock regularly review vendor relationships as the contract term expires. It is the practice of the Council Rock School District to put the services out to RFP.
- 3. What does Champions currently pay to the district on an annual basis?**
  - a. In order to insure its competitive advantage in the RFP process, the district is not going to disclose the current revenue sharing percentage.
- 4. Where are the day-off programs located? One school, multiple schools?**
  - a. Council Rock currently have a day-off program. Inclusion of any day-off program information in the RFP was done in error. Vendors will not be required to provide day-off services.
- 5. Does the current provider offer an on-site summer camp?**
  - a. No
- 6. Why isn't Kindergarten Enrichment offered in all the elementary schools? (space constraints or Champions is not able to provide?)**
  - a. The reason is not solely due to capacity or inability to provide services. At this time it is the District's prerogative to offer Kindergarten Enrichment at three locations.
- 7. Would the incoming provider have access to the school's WIFI?**
  - a. Vendors will not have a direct WIFI connection. However, vendors have complete access to the CRSD public WIFI.
