142. MIGRANT STUDENTS	
1. Authority SC 1327 20 U.S.C. Sec. 6391 et seq 34 CFR 200.81-200.88	The Board establishes a program to address the needs and provide appropriate services to migrant students attending district schools.
2. Definition	A migrant child is defined as a child age 3-21 who has moved across a school district line with/or to join a migrant parent/guardian or on their own within the preceding 36 months in order to obtain temporary or seasonal employment in qualifying agricultural or fishing work including agri-related businesses such as meat or vegetable processing.
3. Guidelines	The district program for migrant students shall include procedures to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Identify migrant students and assess their educational and related health and social needs. 2. Ensure migrant students have the appropriate educational opportunities to meet the same academic standards required of all students. 3. Provide a full range of services to migrant students including applicable Title I programs, special education, gifted education, vocational education, language programs, counseling programs and elective classes. 4. Provide parents/guardians an opportunity for meaningful participation in the program. 5. Provide advocacy and outreach programs for migrant students and their families. 6. Provide professional development for district staff.
