218.11. STUDENTS AND THE POLICE	
1. Purpose Pol. 204	<p>The Board recognizes that compulsory attendance laws impose on the Board the custodianship of the public school children of the district while they are present in the schools. The Board further recognizes that pupil-police or other contact with governmental agencies may occur in our schools and that cooperation with each of these agencies and their staff is necessary to reasonably assure the safety of students, parents/guardians, staff, and our community.</p>
2. Authority	<p>It is the policy of the Board that cooperation with law enforcement agencies is considered essential for the protection of students and staff, maintaining a safe environment in schools and safeguarding district property. Cooperation with police and other governmental agencies, including but not limited to Juvenile and Adult Probation Officers, Children and Youth Caseworkers and other governmental law enforcement officials will be guided by the applicable law and the best interest of the students in our school district.</p> <p>The Board charges the Superintendent of Schools to promulgate administrative regulations that specifically guide access of law enforcement personnel to schools and to our students.</p> <p>.</p>
