POLICIES/ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS</p> <p>Section 1. <u>Board Procedures</u></p> <p>Board procedures are the by laws or rules adopted to regulate the Board's internal operations. These procedures specify the legal basis for the functions, responsibilities and actions of the Board. The 000 Section of the Policy Manual will be comprised of Board procedures.</p> <p>Section 2. <u>Board Policies</u></p> <p>Board policies are official statements which serve as a guide for decision-making. Adopting and revising policies is the function of the Board. Only those policies officially adopted by the Board shall be included in the Policy Manual.</p> <p>The working relationships between the Board and the Superintendent, between administrative-supervisory personnel and the principals, between the principals and their respective staffs shall be clarified in the policies adopted by the Board. Relevant policies shall foster cooperative and effective administration.</p> <p>Section 3. <u>Administrative Regulations</u></p> <p>Administrative regulations are developed and utilized, as necessary, to interpret and implement policies adopted by the Board. Administrative regulations shall be printed on blue paper.</p> <p>Development and implementation of administrative regulations are the responsibility of the Superintendent.</p> <p>New administrative regulations shall be presented for Board review at the next regular meeting of the Board.</p> <p>Administrative procedures shall be democratic, utilizing appropriate skills of staff members.</p>
