418.2. TERRORISTIC THREATS/CONDUCT	
<p>1. Purpose</p> <p>18 Pa C.S.A. Sec. 2706</p>	<p>The Board recognizes the danger that terroristic threats/conduct by professional staff members present to the safety and welfare of district students, staff and community. The Board acknowledges the need for an immediate and effective response to a situation involving such threats/conduct.</p> <p><u>Policy Prohibitions</u></p> <p>No professional staff member shall engage in any conduct, commit any act or make any communication in any manner whatsoever with intent to terrorize another or to cause evacuation of a building, place of assembly or facility of public transportation, or otherwise to cause serious public inconvenience or in reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror or inconvenience.</p>
<p>2. Authority</p>	<p>The Board prohibits any professional staff member from communicating or committing terroristic threats/conduct.</p>
<p>3. Delegation of Responsibility</p> <p>Title 22 Sec. 12.2</p>	<p>The Board directs the Superintendent to react promptly and appropriately to information and knowledge concerning a possible or actual terroristic threat/conduct.</p> <p>The Superintendent shall be responsible for developing administrative regulations to implement this policy.</p> <p>Staff members and students shall be responsible for informing the building principal regarding any information or knowledge relevant to a possible or actual terroristic threat/conduct.</p> <p>The building principal shall immediately inform the Superintendent after receiving a report of such threat/conduct.</p>
<p>4. Guidelines</p>	<p>When the District Superintendent has sufficient, credible, evidence that a professional staff member violated this policy, appropriate disciplinary action will be taken.</p>
