425. DRESS AND GROOMING	
1. Purpose	Teachers set an example in dress and grooming for their students to follow. A teacher should present an image of dignity and encourage respect for authority. These factors act in a positive manner towards the maintenance of classroom discipline.
2. Authority SC 510	The Board has the authority to specify reasonable dress and grooming guidelines for staff, within law, that will prevent such matters from having an adverse impact on the educational process.
3. Guidelines	All staff members shall, when assigned to district duty, be physically clean, neat, well-groomed and dressed in a manner reflecting professional assignment.
