<p>1. Purpose</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">130. HOMEWORK</p> <p>Homework assignments should complement the school instruction. The assignments should develop student responsibility, good study habits, and organizational skills. Homework assignments should serve to enhance and enrich the learning process in the following ways:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Gives the student the experience of developing initiative, self-discipline, responsibility, and independence.</li> <li>2. Helps the student develop and practice study skills needed for obtaining knowledge independently.</li> <li>3. Develops life-long learning that encourages student inquiry.</li> <li>4. Enriches the classroom experience by relating what has been learned in school to everyday problem-solving situations.</li> </ol> <p>The appropriate completion of homework may be part of a student's marking period grade. Student health, responsibilities, and interests outside of the classroom may be taken into consideration on an individual basis in assessing the frequency of homework completion.</p> <p>Required reference materials for the completion of student assignments are accessible within the libraries, reference centers, and databases provided by the district. The use of other sources may be encouraged by teachers; however, the use of libraries and other sources outside the district shall not be required for earning course credits, nor shall the use of outside sources be a factor in determining grades.</p>
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
